Back to school...

Everyone - with the exception of some of the pupils - wants schools to reopen as quickly and fully as possible. Everyone - including the pupils - needs to be aware that school reopening occurs to the extent that it's safe to do so. Every school is individual so every school needs it's own risk assessment and it's own plan. Those plans will then need to be resourced.

Clear guidance on safe working in schools and early learning in the face of this deadly virus has been **published** (and see below). These will allow for some classroom based teaching to resume safely. It is easy to proclaim things should proceed more quickly, but schools don't have signs outside saying 'beyond this point the Health & Safety at work Act no longer applies'. The return of pupils, whatever the pace, has to happen in a manner consistent with guidelines, not at the risk of peoples lives.

Claps and rainbows are great ...but they don't pay the bills:

UNISON Scotland has asked, fruitlessly so far, for NHS pay negotiations to be reopened. This is in the wake of the pandemic. Whilst many people were forced into inactivity for NHS staff the situation was very different. we have begun surveying UNISON members in NHS about the impact of coronavirus. Within 24 hours we had received over 7000 replies (the survey is ongoing for another 10 days) . People are reporting childcare costs, extra transport costs because they can't use restricted public transport, are washing their clothes more often, have been isolating from family, and are mentally and physically exhausted. This effort and commitment needs to be properly acknowledged - **'a clap is appreciated but wont pay our bills'**
